

Discovery Bible Study

You are about to embark on a great adventure! There is no lesson to prepare, nor specific text questions. The outline given below is the only tool you need! Below is a detailed explanation of the outline, followed by a skeleton outline that you can print off and put in your Bible. The Discovery Bible Study is best done in a group BUT can be done individually. The goal of the Discovery Bible Study is discover the truth about God, life and happiness. Jesus said that He came to this world so that you and I would abundant life, a life filled with joy.

So let's begin.

Step One: You need a bible or access to one on your phone or laptop. (ie.Biblegateway)

Step Two: Look up the passage selected for the week (listed below)

Step Three: Questions to ask at the beginning of your Discovery Bible Study. (suggestion: journal your thoughts for later reflection)

- A. What are you thankful for today?
- B. What difficulties or problems have you had the past week?

Step Three: Read the passage and then retell the story in your own words. If you are in a group have someone else retell the story.

Step Four: Questions to ask about the scripture selection:

- A. What do these verses teach us about God or about people?
- B. What commands do I need to apply to my life? Use sentences like "I will....."
- C. Who will I share this teaching from the lesson with this week?
